The *Journal of Public Affairs Education* invites proposals for publication in a special issue addressing the topic of “The Quality of Public Service Education in Mexico”. Topics include those which comprised the agenda of the jointly-sponsored NASPAA – INAP – INPAE conference held in Mexico City on January 24-25, 2017. Specifically, we seek papers addressing:

1. The panorama of Mexican graduate education in public affairs and how to improve the quality of public service education
2. The importance of contextual learning and its significance in a Mexican context
3. The role of Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs) in public service education in Mexico
4. The Mexican experience in quality assurance for public service education within a global context
5. Opportunities for international, inter-associational and inter-institutional collaborations to enhance the quality of Mexican public service education

Please send a one-page proposal or questions to the special issue guest editors listed below by **February 20, 2017**. Authors will be notified if their proposals have been accepted by **March 15, 2017**. First drafts of papers will be due by **August 1, 2017** for guest editor feedback. Full manuscripts are due by **November 1, 2017**. All submitted papers will be peer-reviewed and accepted papers will be published in the *Journal of Public Affairs Education* in **July 2018**.

Authors notified if proposals are accepted: **March 15, 2017**

Deadline to submit first draft: **August 1, 2017**

Feedback provided by guest editors: **September 1, 2017**

Deadline to submit full manuscript: **November 1, 2017**
