Charge to the Simulation Committee

December 1, 2024

On behalf of NASPAA President Mohamad Alkadry, the charge for the NASPAA Simulation Committee for 2024-2025 is below. The Committee is expected to use the reporting tool (attached) to monitor its progress. A report is to be presented at the May 2025 Executive Council meeting.

The Committee is charged with:

- 1. Assessing the Modality of the Student Competition:** Evaluate whether the Student Simulation Competition should remain fully virtual or transition to a hybrid format, incorporating both online and in-person sites. The Committee's recommendation should be included in its May report to the Council.
- 2. Reviewing the Committee Structure:** Collaborate with the NASPAA Teaching and Learning Committee to identify areas for collaboration and determine whether the work should continue to be done by two separate committees. The Committee should include its recommendation in the May report to the Council.
- 3. Promoting Its Work:** Prepare and deliver a webinar during Spring 2025. The webinar should highlight the Committee's ongoing work and promote the use of simulations in the classroom, the Student Simulation Competition, and the Publicases.org platform.
- 4. Continuing Support for Competition and Workshop Planning:** Consistent with previous years, continue to assist NASPAA staff in planning and executing the Student Simulation Competition and the Simulation Workshop at the NASPAA Annual Conference.
