

Charge to the Teaching and Learning Committee

December 1, 2024

On behalf of NASPAA President Mohamad Alkadry, the charge for the NASPAA Teaching and Learning Committee for 2024-2025 is below. The Committee is expected to use the reporting tool (attached) to monitor its progress. A report is to be presented at the March 2025 Executive Council meeting.

The Committee is charged with the following:

- 1. **Assessing the Effectiveness of Core Services:** Build on last year's charge to evaluate the effectiveness of NASPAA's core services (e.g., Publicases) and professional development programs (e.g., NASPAA Next). The evaluation should include recommendations for additional teaching and learning resources that would benefit NASPAA member schools. A detailed report is expected to be presented at the March 2025 Council meeting.
- 2. **Enhancing Access to Publicases:** Increase member engagement with Publicases by hosting a webinar in Spring 2025 to educate NASPAA members on its use and value. Additionally, the Committee should develop and execute a plan to open Publicases to prospective members for a six-month trial period to increase traffic.
- 3. **Collaborating with Other Committees:** Collaborate with JPAE, the Simulation Committee, and other NASPAA committees to enhance the diversity of cases available on the Publicases platform. This includes soliciting cases for simultaneous publication in JPAE and Publicases, with an emphasis on contributions from both U.S. and international members.
- 4. **Reviewing the Committee Structure**: Collaborate with the NASPAA Simulation Committee to identify areas for collaboration and determine whether the work should continue to be done by two separate committees. The Committee should include its recommendation in the May report to the Council.
