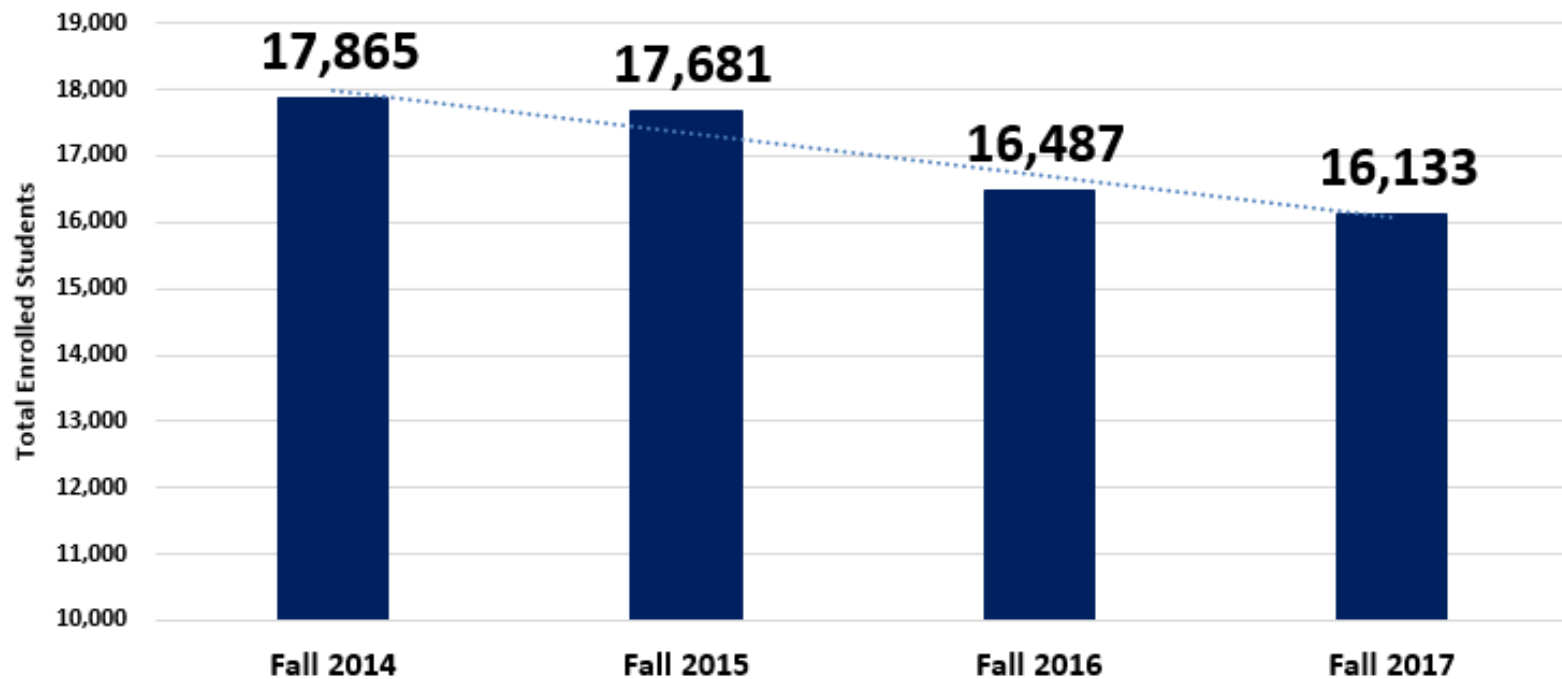

NASPAA Fall Enrollment Trend



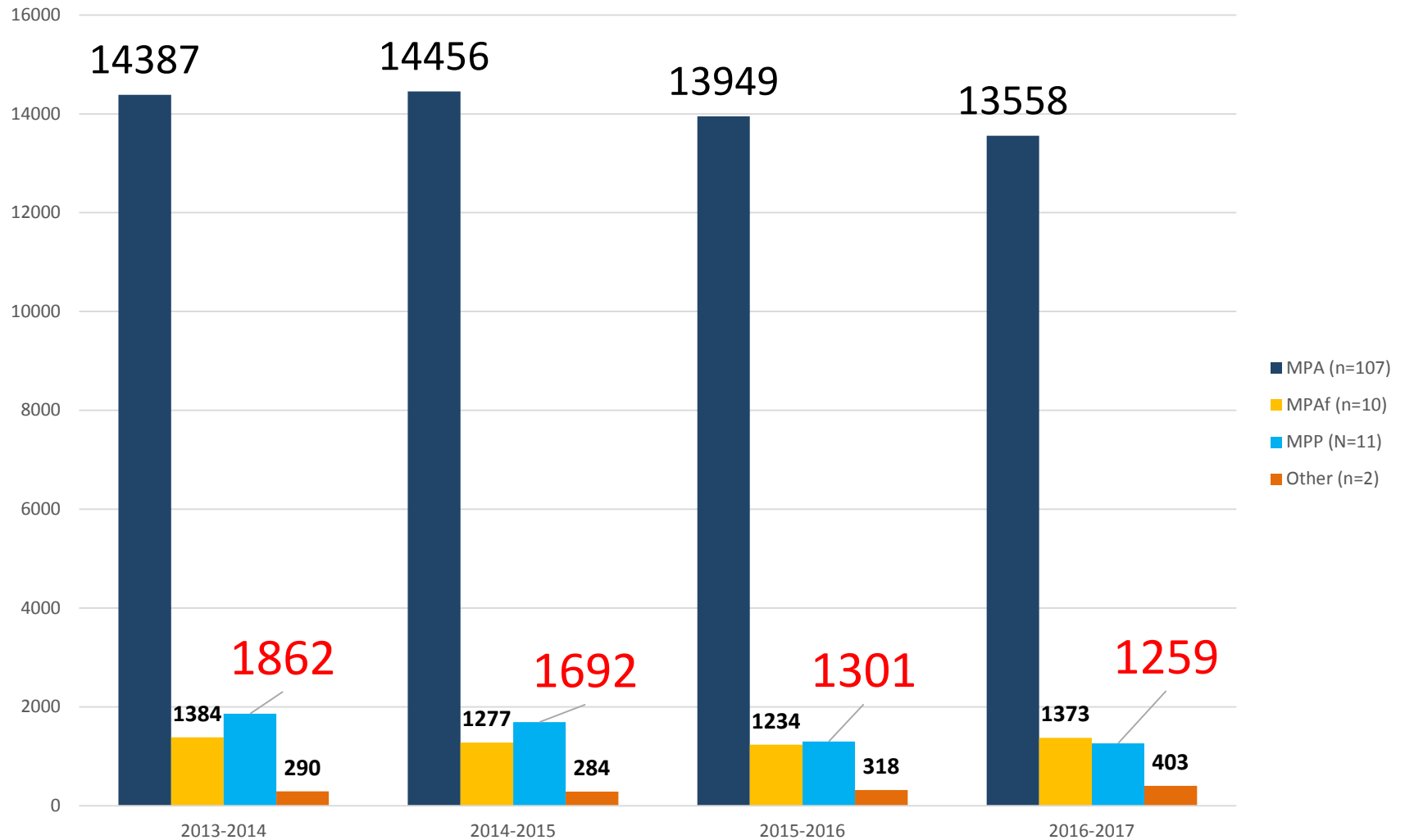

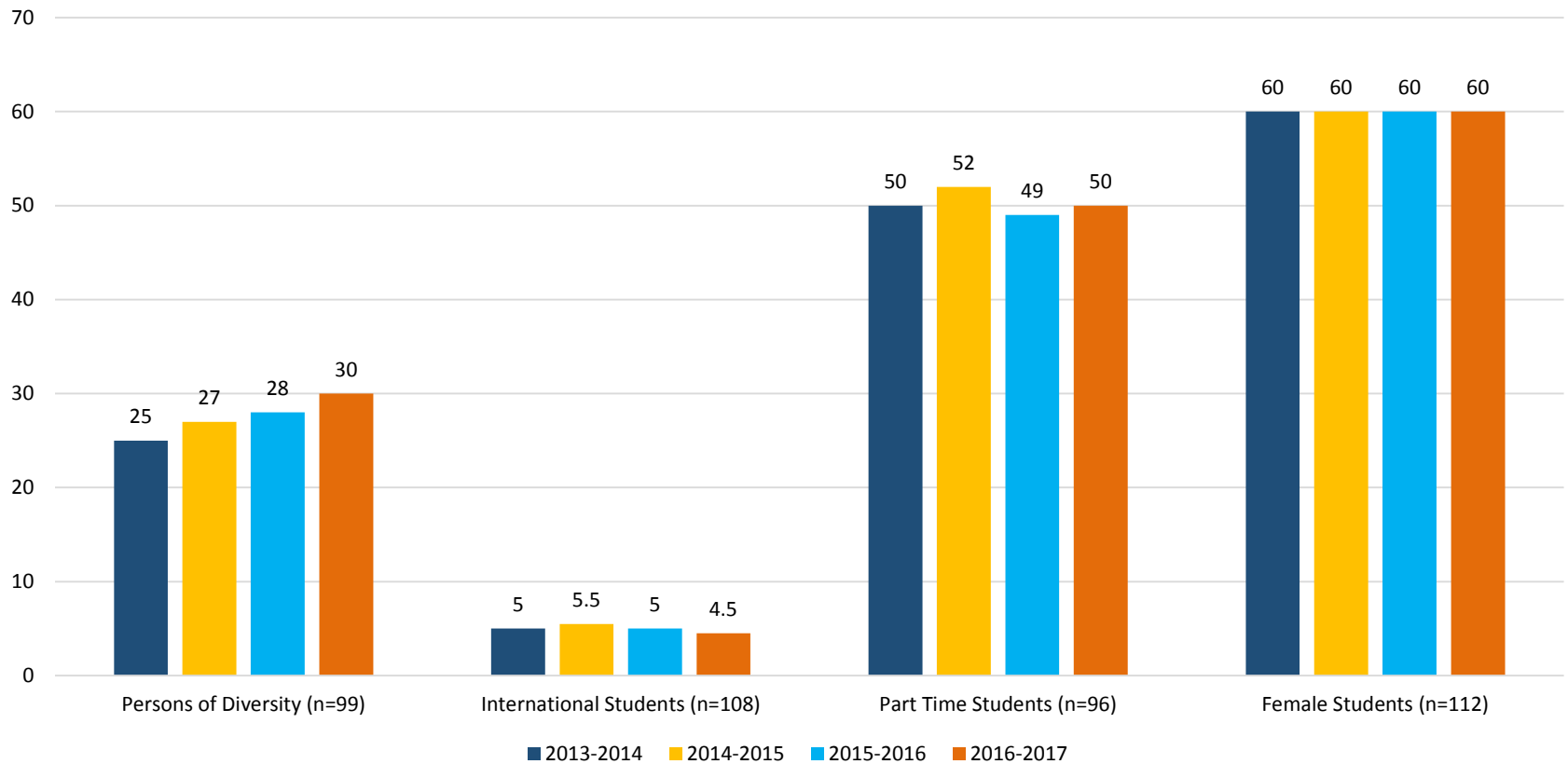

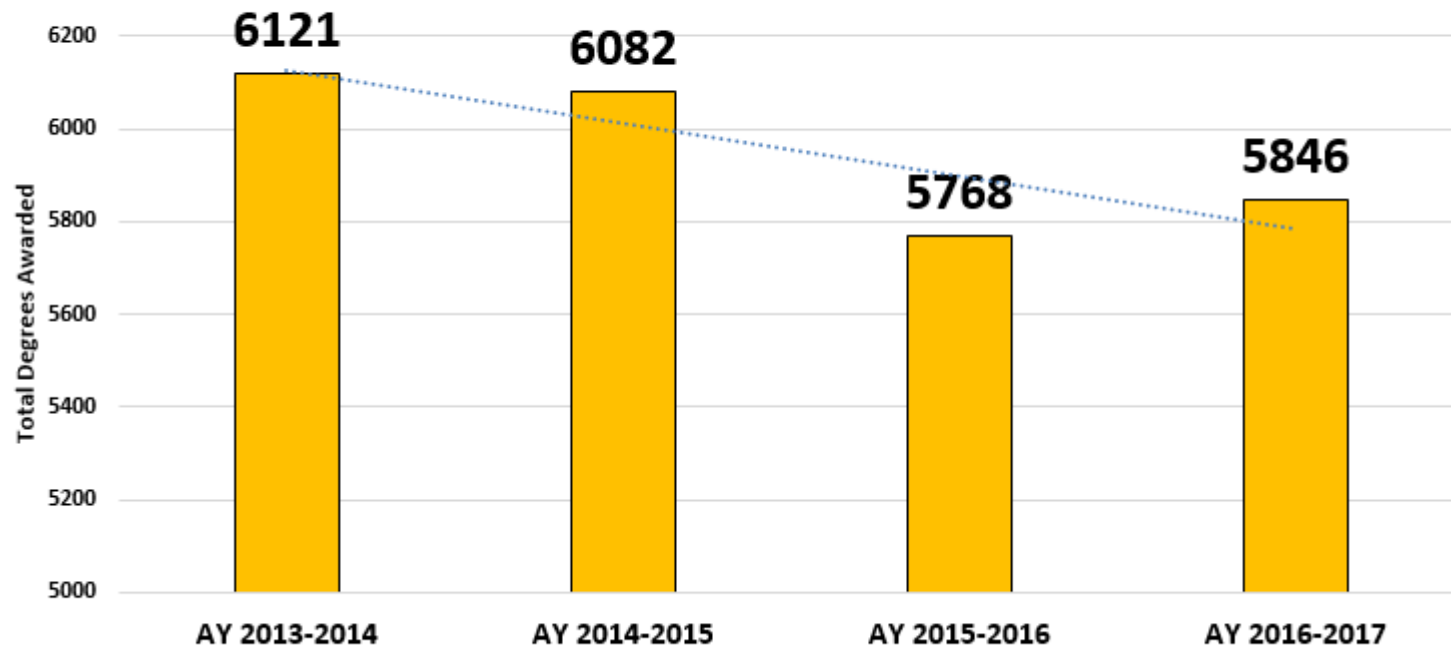


Average Percent Enrolled By Category (Trends)





NASPAA Degrees Awarded Trend

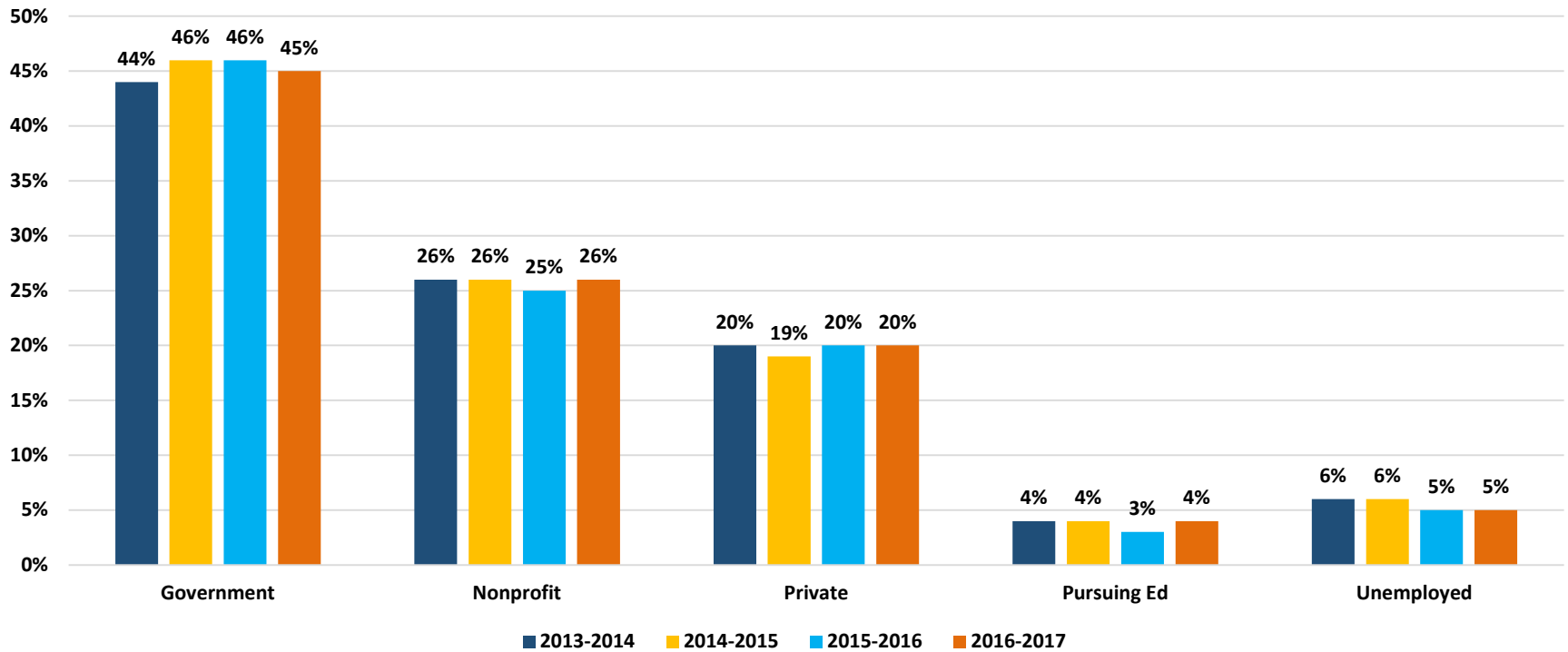


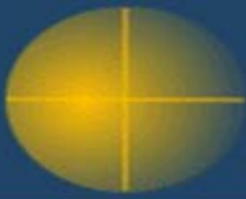

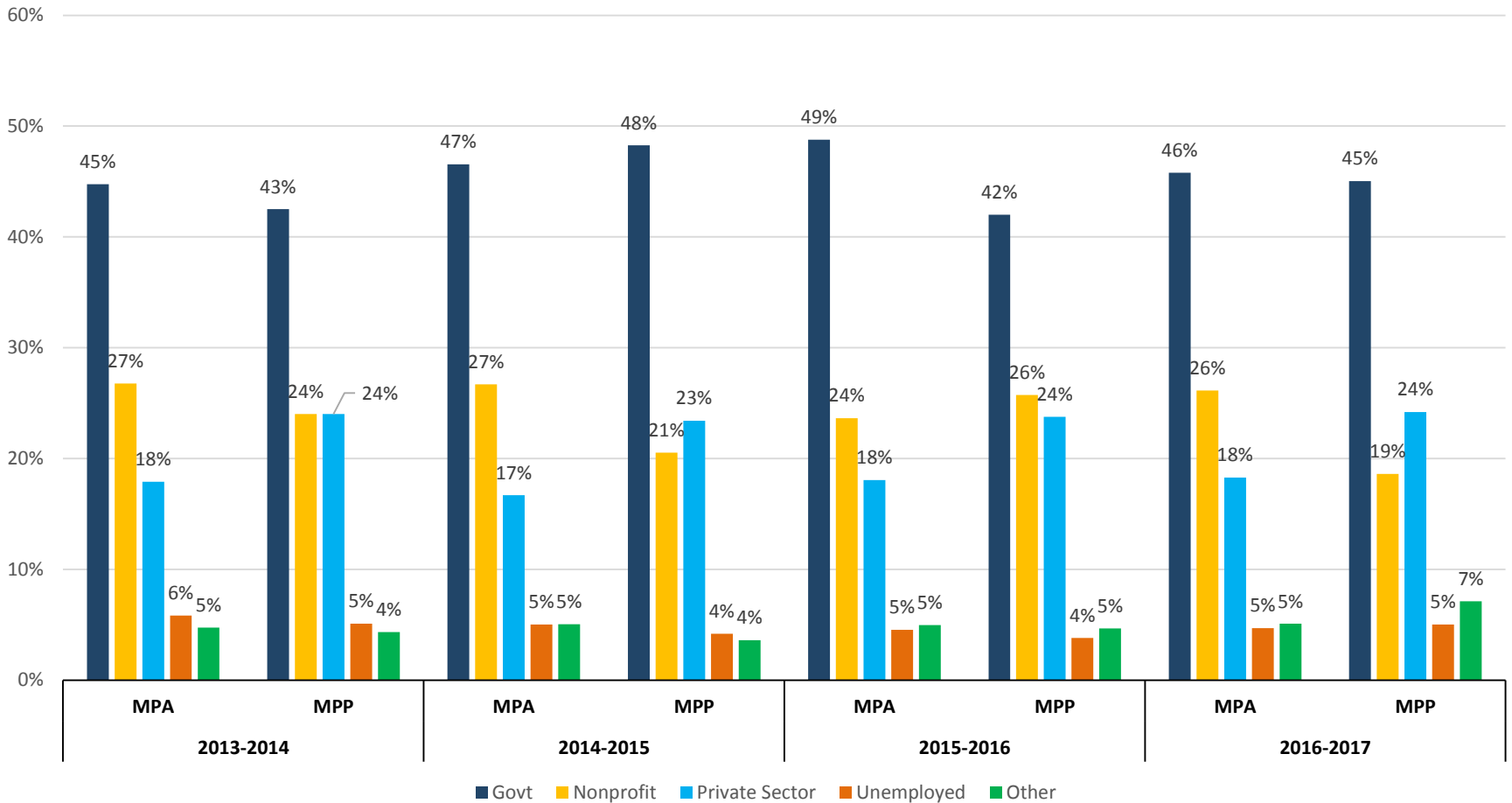
Employment Trends (N=162 programs)

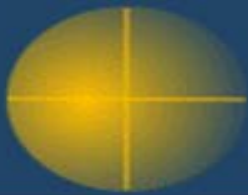




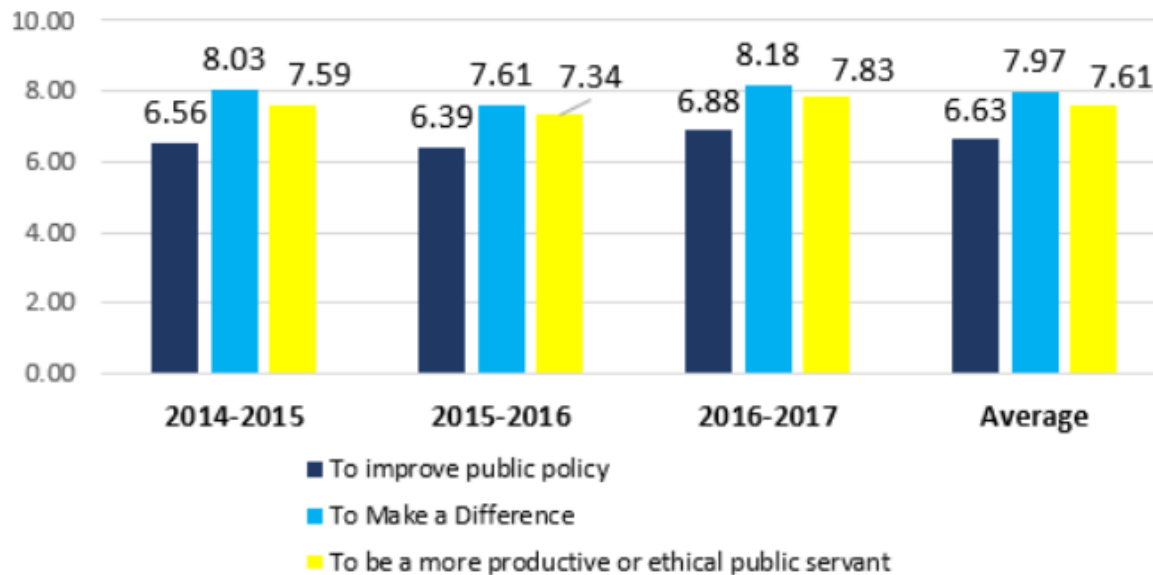
Enrollment Trends By Degree Type

(MPA= 135 programs, MPP= 15 Programs)

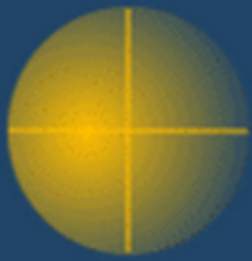




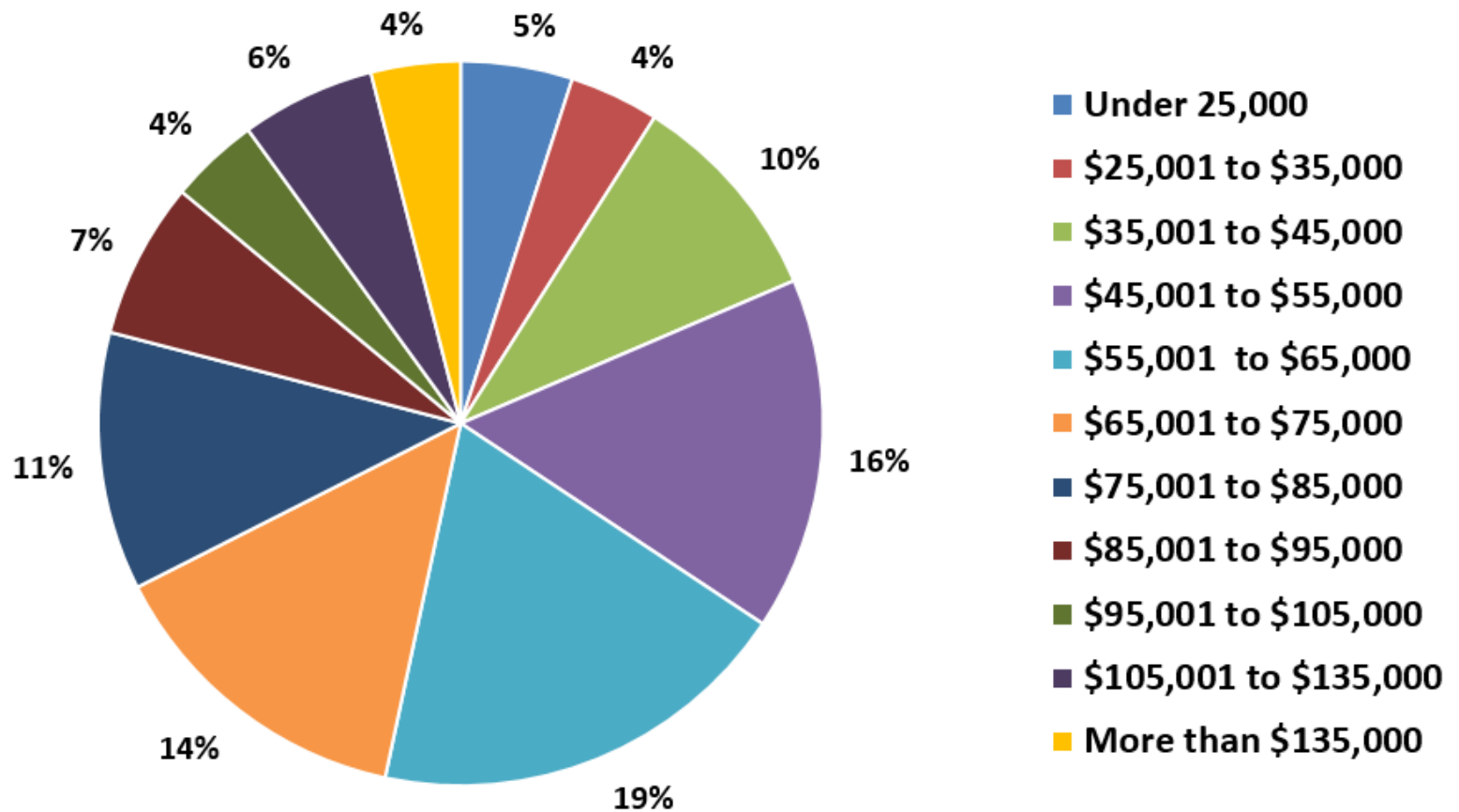
Motivation for Seeking Degree (Scale 1-10)

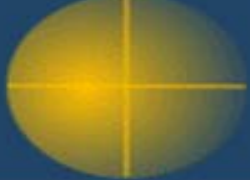

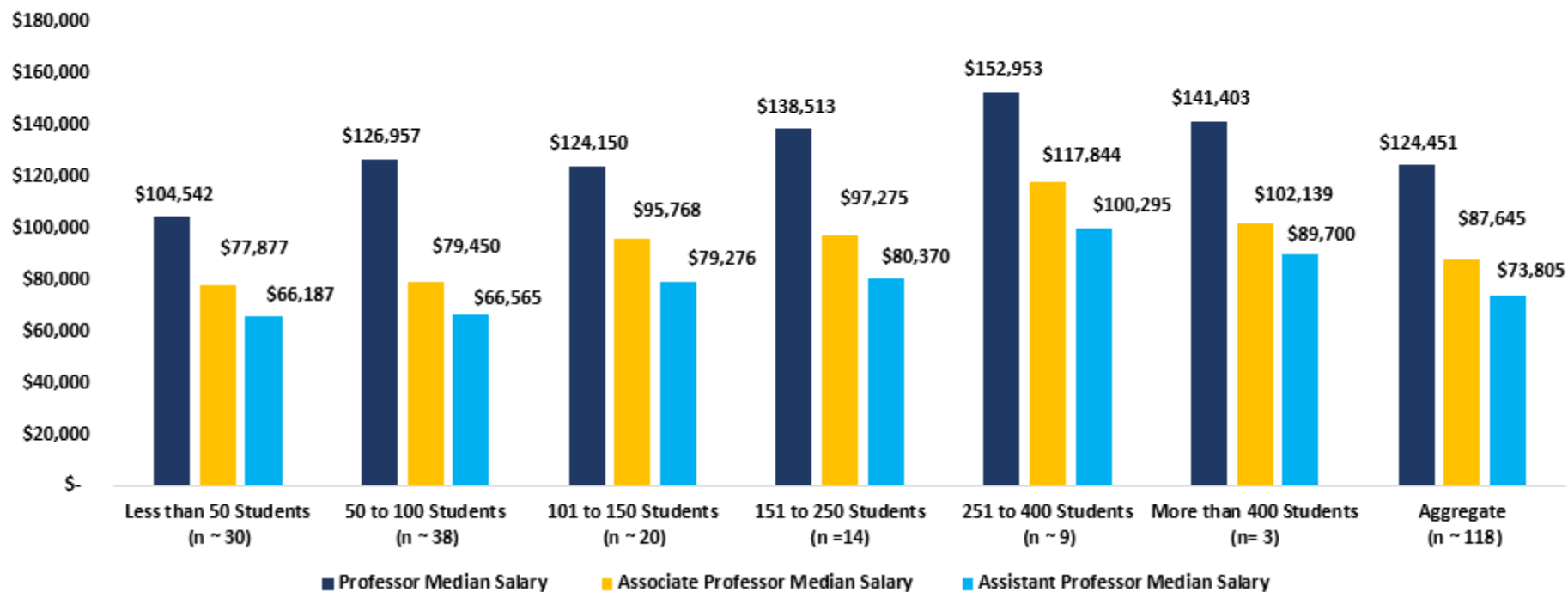


Alumni Salary Three Years Out (n=1974)

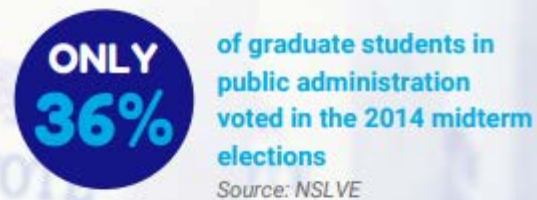
